

Notes of ZCH meeting Tues 20th October 2020

- 1. We agreed the notes of our last meeting, matters arising were:
 - -The Repair café is now On-Line, with a form on website to request a repair.
- -Our support for a Bucks Citizens Assembly, Action -Karen will circulate a paper and a link to a webinar for info.
- 2. **E-Bike event and feedback:** Very successful event. 27 bookings and around 40 people turned up to try bikes and one sale on the day. Action to ask Parish council to consider need for outdoor charging post for e-bikes at village hall site.
- 3. Re-Leaf project: Kirsten had a productive meeting with Councillor Bill Chapple and Council officials re the project. Ed Barlow, Alex Beckett, David Sutherland and Councillor Dave Lyons also attended. The council are setting up a "Task and Finish" group to support a roll out for the county. This will include joined -up working with Highways to find tree planting sites. Action next re- leaf meeting 7pm 27th October, Kirsten to send Zoom invite.
 - Diccon and Greg have surveyed Townsend Green and the Rec. and Spicers yard want to engage in project. Action Diccon to draw up survey and recommendations.
- 4. Communication and Information sharing. Actions notes of meetings to be made public on ZCH website. A distribution list of Trustees and other attendees at meetings to be created. And a zoom invite for our next meeting to go to people who have signed up for re –Leaf and ZCH information. Roy to be asked for advice re Communication strategy.
- 5. **Electric car club:** Alan has met with Thame Green Living group who are interested in working with ZCH on car club.

Information from Hook Norton car club to be reviewed. Consider looking at information from "Co-Wheels" in Oxford and others. Action to consider the various models and start to formulate a plan. Warren White – Bucks councillor has expressed support for this type of project

- 6. **Feedback re Charity application and Bank account.** Waiting for response from the Charity Commission after responding to their request for more information, and Bank account now established but cannot be activated until Charity Commission agree our charity status and give us a number.
- 7. **Lobbying**: Community Board, Kirsten attended and has joined Environment sub group. Greg has joined Transport Sub group and this group contacting the Police to ask for action re 20mph speed limit. Bucks Climate Action Alliance (BCAA)Karen attending meetings, someone else will need to get involved when Karen and Robin move.
- 8. Village society presentation from Parish councillor Dave O'Hanlon, Diccon attended the meeting. Food waste project to be piloted, volunteers needed to trial an App. Action -Diccon to ask Parish council if they need/we can offer assistance on pushing forward with next actions in the plan
- 9. AOBs Dave Lyons has resigned from parish council. Actions, Greg to ask Parish clerk if there is to be an election for PC in May. Both Greg and Alan will consider standing. "Pop up" cycle lane- Lots of local complaints. Poor implementation of plan with little information for local people and lane only goes one way- so it has proved unpopular. Action -all to ask for 20mph part of the plan to remain even if the cycle lane goes, and extend 20mph to whole village

Exploratory Meeting with Dandara Housing developers- they want to support Environmental issues. Kirsten and Greg to meet them on 26th October 9.30 am by 700m.

Webinar from Oxford Low energy Hub 19th November – Diccon to circulate information.
